



Garden Coordinator

The Garden Coordinator is responsible to plan, plant, and tend a food/learning garden for camp and to create opportunities for campers and the Kintail community to take part in caring for and learning about the garden.

Responsibilities:

- Plan a basic layout for the garden and ensure the necessary seeds and plants are purchased.
- Work with fellow staff members to prepare the soil and use the compost from the previous year.
- Plant the garden, ensuring that it is planted at different stages so there is produce ready throughout the season.
- Ensure that the garden is well watered and rotor-tilled throughout the season.
- Plan sessions for school groups and summer campers, incorporating various aspects of gardening, composting, the plant life cycle, organic growing, food tasting etc. The sessions should include time helping to tend the garden by weeding or picking vegetables.
- Ensure that the garden tools, equipment, and Garden Outpost are always left clean, tidy and organized.
- Prepare sessions for Staff Orientation or Staff Training as requested.
- Within reasonable limits, perform other duties as assigned by the Assistant Director and/or Camp Director including maintenance, kitchen, office, and special program projects.
- Assist with counselling campers when required.
- Provide the Director with a written final report. The final report should contain details about the program area as well as recommendations for the future.

Qualifications:

- Experience and interest in the area of organic gardening/agriculture.
- A spirit of flexibility and high degree of initiative.
- A valid "G" level driver's license is desirable.
- Experience working with children.
- A willingness to work in a team environment.
- Standard First Aid with CPR "C".
- A personal living faith.
- Previous camp experience is an asset
