## Kitchen Assistant

The Kitchen Assistant works closely with the Kitchen Manager to prepare all meals & snacks at camp, in compliance with federal, provincial, and local food safety legislation. They must also help to maintain a clean and organized kitchen throughout the spring and summer, including doing dishes, regular cleaning and sanitizing, and ensuring safe and organized food storage. In addition, the Kitchen Assistant assists with buffet management and the occasional serving of food to campers, staff, and guests.

### Responsibilities:

- Assist the Kitchen Manager in the preparation of all meals and snacks.
- During the meal, assist with hosting, monitoring buffet, and ensuring the hospitality center is stocked.
- Carry out food service in accordance with all regulations of federal, provincial and local authoritative bodies, and any additional standards of safety and health established by Camp Kintail.
- Assist in the organization and preparation of dietary alternatives for guests, staff, and campers.
- Ensure that all kitchen dishes are washed after each meal.
- Keep the staff fridge stocked and cleaned, in consultation with the Kitchen Manager. This includes removing food which has passed its best before date.
- Work with the Kitchen Manager and Program Coordinator in incorporating the theme into meals.
- Work closely with the Kitchen Manager and Outdoor Adventure Director in preparation of food supplies for all Outdoor Adventure camps.
- Assist with serving during weddings, retreats, rentals and other special events.
- Attend all staff meetings and training.
- Perform all other duties as assigned by the Camp Director or Kitchen Manager with generosity and team spirit.
- Assist in counselling campers as requested.

### Qualifications:

- Interest and experience in food service and preparation.
- An education in culinary arts or relevant experience in culinary management is preferred.
- A current Safe Food Handling certificate.
- Experience working with children.
- A willingness to work in a team environment.
- Standard First Aid with CPR "C".
- A personal living faith.
- Previous camp experience is an asset
