

OUTDOOR LIVING SKILLS DIRECTOR

BROAD RESPONSIBILITY:

The Outdoor Living Skills Director is responsible for the designing, implementation and supervision of an outdoor living skills program which compliments Camp Kintail's philosophies, goals and programs

RESPONSIBLE TO:

1. Design appropriate camp crafts lessons for camp sessions considering age and gender of campers, and camp themes.
2. Order supplies needed for the summer with the Executive Director's approval and within budget limits.
3. Organize outdoor living skills sessions teaching skills in backpacking, fire building, shelter building, no trace camping, outdoor cooking, and hiking.
4. Co-ordinate with the Outdoor Adventure Director the use of packs and other equipment necessary for sessions.
5. Include sessions which teach campers and staff about fire safety.
6. Ensure the upmost safety when leading sessions involving fire. Understand the additional risks and how to respond in the case of an emergency.
7. Assist staff members in supervision of campers during sessions by providing them with clear instructions and expectations.
8. Work as a team with the Nature Director, Maintenance Staff, Site Manager, and Executive Director to develop a more environmentally friendly camp and promote environmental awareness.
9. Discuss overall programming, hikes, sessions and on-site tripping with the Directors.
10. Ensure the safe storage of supplies and equipment throughout and at the end of the season.
11. Provide leadership for a Kintail On The Road team.
12. Lead Outdoor Adventure Camps as requested.
13. Provide the Director with a written final report. The final report should contain details about the program area and provide suggestions for the future.

14. Participate fully as a program staff member and by work and deed encourage a faithful Christian witness.

POSSIBLE ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Outdoor Living Skills Director is often also responsible to oversee onsite tripping and/or outdoor adventure camps. They will be informed by the Directors if this is the case, and may refer to the appropriate job descriptions for specific responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A minimum of two years experience as a camp staff member.
2. One year of camp counselling experience.
3. A personal living faith.
4. Knowledge and experience of the natural world, environmental concerns, and out-tripping.
5. A passion for sharing a love of God's creation with campers.
6. A willingness to work in a team environment.
7. A Standard First Aid Certificate with CPR "C".
