

RESOURCE STAFF - FLOATER

BROAD RESPONSIBILITY:

The Floater is responsible to be a “supply” program staff for the various areas of camp. This will allow program staff members to know that their area will be well covered when they are away at Kintail on the Road or on their time off.

RESPONSIBLE TO:

1. Lead a program area when a program staff member is not leading their specific area.
2. Providing leadership for other areas that program staff may have responsibility for – closing worship, selling clothing, lost and found, etc.
3. When not covering another area, they would be responsible to either the waterfront or the ropes course.
4. Use their own or the program staff's lesson plans for their area, ensuring fun, safety, and growth for the campers.
5. Ensure that the program area is left clean and tidy and ready for the program staff to return.
6. Help the Program Director with the theme throughout the week.
7. Prepare sessions for Staff Orientation or Staff Training as requested.
8. Provide leadership for a Kintail On The Road team.
9. Lead a week of Outdoor Adventure camp as requested.
10. Provide the Director with a written final report. The final report should contain details about the program area and suggestions for the future.
11. Participate fully as a program staff member and by word and deed encourage a faithful Christian witness.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A minimum three years of experience as a camp staff member.
2. One year of camp counseling experience.
3. Preference will be given to applicants with at least one year of program experience.
4. Experience and qualifications in waterfront or ropes.

5. Experience in at least one other area – music and drama, arts and crafts, outdoor living skills, nature, or adventure.
6. A personal living faith.
7. A great deal of flexibility.
8. A willingness to work in a team environment.
9. A valid “G” level driver’s license and insurable on the camp van is desirable.
10. A Standard First Aid Certificate with CPR “C”.
