We have been in conversation with Huron Perth Public Health as the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) situation continues to evolve and will follow their advice and wisdom. We are committed to posting regular updates about our plans and policies around the virus.

At this point, our operations and programs are continuing as scheduled. This includes the Winter Craft Retreat, Kintail on the Road (at New St. James Presbyterian Church, London and Nassagaweya Presbyterian Church), and the March Break Family Retreat.
